



## DESIGN FOR A PLATE FOR THUMB-SCREWS.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 33,075, dated August 14, 1900.

Application filed June 7, 1900. Serial No. 19,476. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM H. DAVEN-PORT, a citizen of the United States, residing at Norwich, in the county of New London and State of Connecticut, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Plates for Thumb-Screws, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, in which—

Figure 1 is a plan view of the obverse face of a plate for thumb-screws, showing my new design; and Fig. 2 is a reverse view of the same. Fig. 3 is an edge view of said plate.

As shown in the said drawings, the leading or material feature of my design consists in a plate of disk-like form, having its obverse

face checked and its reverse face smooth and having a portion of its edge cut away, as shown. Opposite the said cut-away portion is a radially-extending arm whose width is about 20 equal to the thickness of the said disk and whose length is approximately equal to one-half the diameter of the said disk.

Having described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters 25 Patent, is—

The design for a plate for thumb-screws, substantially as herein shown and described. WILLIAM II. DAVENPORT.
